🕻 Walk on the right

Cycle on the left side

Only walk or cycle as a two

Slow down as you go around bends and at junctions - always be prepared to stop!

Keeping safe on the Redways

It is important to keep yourself and others safe using the Redways.

Don't listen to music too loudly and be aware of what's around you

Let others pass if it becomes busy

🔆 When passing others let them know by politely telling them or using a bell on your bike

Give other users space and slow down when you overtake them

Take your rubbish home or put it in the nearest bin

Getting Around

If you see a yellow bollard, slow down, it probably means you are near a road or junction.

If you see a white triangle it means **give way**. You do this by stopping to let traffic pass before you and only crossing when it's safe to do so.
